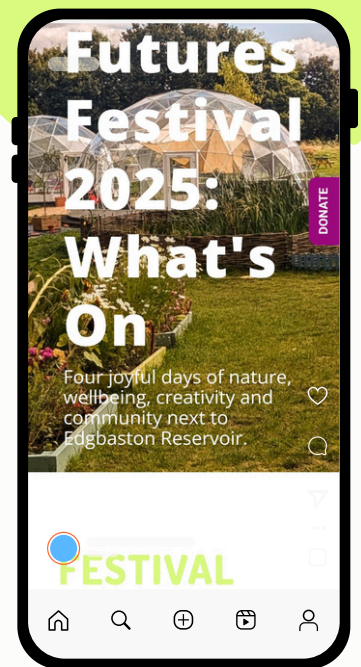
FORESTS: PERFORMANCE & WORKSHOP

RoguePlay is an award winning contemporary circus company, creating a unique style of theatre using aerial and ground based circus, dance and spoken word. They produce shows centred around empowering women, advocating for inclusivity and the climate crisis.

Internationally-toured *Forests* packs a powerful punch, challenging forestry practices, our over-consumption of timber, destruction of rainforests and displacement of indigenous peoples. Be amazed as you enjoy fiery acrobatics and dance in this highly-visual family-friendly show.

After the performances, stay for a workshop aimed at young people and families, explore birds, monkeys and bears before having a go at the acrobatics.
